

2023 Final Millage Rates as Adopted by Taxing Authorities

Taxing Authorities have voted and adopted their final millage rates and the percent of tax increase/decrease over the rolled back rate. Each Taxing Authority has certified their budget and millage rate decisions to the Florida Department of Revenue. The Property Appraiser will now certify the final tax roll to the Tax Collector to generate bills in November.
